Creating Your Custom Splash Page

With the MrX Premium Web Traffic Platform

Overview: MrX Resellers have access to text boxes in their members area where they can enter html code that will cause whatever the code represents to appear on their custom page.

Custom Webpage: you have a module in your resources area titled, Custom Web Pages where you may copy the URL shown under the image of the page, into the custom link section in your members area to make your custom affiliate link that will display the new custom web page.

Elements: Each text box will create an, "element" on your page. You have 7 elements you may use when creating your custom page. You may use all 7 or you may choose to use only one or two.


The elements are, Headline, Sub-headline, Video or Image, Autoresponder, Text or Bullet Points and two images.

Your Headline This is where you enter the html code for your headline	align:center"> It's A Pure Miracle! </span

Elements: Each text box will create an, "element" on your page. You have 7 elements you may use when creating your custom page. You may use all 7 or you may choose to use only one or two.

How to make code for your textboxes


In order to make text, images or videos appear on a webpage we must enter code and tell the computer what to upload to the server and then display world wide. If you already know code you will not need this step. If you do not know how to write in html code, then we are going to use an editor that almost all of us are at least familiar with.

We will make what we want on the editor page and then we'll select "source" to show us the html code.

We will copy the html code into the text boxes.

You may have to experiment a few times to get the right size for your text and images and video but just make the code, paste it in, have a look and then adjust as needed.


Here's the website with a free html editor. If it looks familiar it's because most of us have used a similar editor to make documents!



Now Let's Do An Example Element And Get The html Code!

Now Let's Get Our Code





All we need to do is to click or tap on the "source" button and our code will be displayed...

Once we copy and paste the code, we can click or tap on the source button again if we want to return to the regular view version.

Next... We copy our code into the text box where we want that code to appear!

Example: Our headline will go in text box #1 and our video code will go into text box #3.

When can I get code without any work?

When inserting an autoresponder if you want one, or when inserting a video...

Both services, ie., YouTube for video and GetResponse for autorepsonders for example...

Will both provide you the html code already for you to cut and paste into your text box in our members area.

Examples: First YouTube for a video embed code:

Just go to your youtube account, click or tap to make a video, record it with your webcam or do a screen shot video. Then when it is rendered and ready for viewing...

Find your video, underneath will be the word "SHARE" click or tap. You will see the "EMBED" option, click on that and you will see the video pop up with the embed code ready for you to copy into your text box!

See the picture...



For your autoresponder, it's similar, just create your webform to capture names and emails and they will provide you with the code to cut and paste.

If you need help, open a browser and type the words, "**HOW DO I**" and then the question you have.

Example: How do I make a get response autoresponder email capture form?

Example: How do I get my Youtube embed code...

If you want an excellent video channel that is all yours that you can put autoresponder forms right in the videos, buy buttons and more, and advertise with it and get embed codes, this is the one I use <u>http://VideoManPro.com</u>

Here is the step by step process to create your page...

- 1) Find the webpage template you want located in the MrX Members area, titled, "Custom Web Pages".
- 2) Figure out what text boxes you want to use. If you want to keep the "Element" then use the code you see and copy it into your text box to make your page.
- 3) If you want to change the element and use your own code, then go make it as described in this document and past that code into the text box you want it to appear in.
- 4) Once all the text boxes that you want to use have html code in them and the one's you do not want to use are left empty, click or tap, "SAVE" under the code boxes.
- 5) That's it you are done making your page!

How to View your custom link page...

Select the webpage template you like best, there will be more as time goes on and I add new one's for us...

And cut and paste that URL into your members area in the custom link box.

Then click or tap, "Make Link" and copy the big long ugly link our system makes.

Yes it's a great idea to get your own domain name (URL) and forward it to your big ugly custom page link.

If you need to learn how to do that, either call Godaddy.com or type, "How Do I Forward a GoDaddy domain name to my affiliate link?" and you will find out just how to do it, it's easy!

So with the big ugly link or your new professional URL....

Cut and paste it into a browsers address bar and click or tap, "Enter" and you will see your page!

Very Important Note...

You may have to clear your browsers cache every time you look in case your internet service provider or your computer is "holding" or caching your images for faster loads.

Clearing your cache will allow you to see the "NEW" page each time you make corrections or new pages.

IF you need to do this, remember the, "How Do I" method of learning how to do new things!

Tips to help you make good pages...

Your images and text will probably not look right the first time you cut and paste them in, so you wil have to go change the sizing so they fit and look good.

For example the text may be too big, or too small, or need less word to fit at all.. just go do your fixes, recut and paste and check it again!
